**COVID-19 Status Report  
Oak Park Village Board of Trustees**

To: Village President and Village Board of Trustees

The memo is a means to share a brief summary of information regarding Village of Oak Park operational activities in response to COVID-19. In most cases, formal public guidance or employee guidance has been publicly disseminated via the Village website or Village social media channels.

**New Public Health Guidance**

Today, the Village of Oak Park Department of Public Health received notification of the following new COVID-19 cases:

Excluding individuals for which street addresses are not yet determined, the State of Illinois reports a total of two thousand six hundred and sixty-four (2664) Oak Park COVID-19 cases. It is important to note that as patient tracking and case follow-up occurs, individuals listing the number of Oak Park cases reported may change depending on residency confirmation.

The Oak Park Department of Public Health is notified of positive tests as established by state and local public health protocol. Because of privacy laws, no additional information can be released about the individuals. It is noted, that privacy precludes location information regarding individuals tested to anyone other than Public Health Officials and First Responders.

The Oak Park Department of Public Health is working closely with officials from the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), investigating and notifying anyone who may have had exposure to the individual who tested positive for COVID-19. Local public health officials, hospitals and first responders are following protocols consistent with the latest guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Also, Interim Oak Park Public Health Director Joseph Terry reported today the forty-ninth death of an Oak Park resident believed to be related to the COVID-19 coronavirus. The fatality is a 94-year-old male. Director Terry expresses his sincere condolences to the resident’s friends and family for the loss of their loved one.

**Vaccinations**

Through today, second doses of vaccine have been administered to staff and residents of Berkeley Nursing & Rehab Center at 6909 West North Avenue, Oak Park Arms at 408 S. Oak Park Avenue, Oak Park Oasis at 625 North Harlem and Belmont Village at 1035 Madison Street. Second doses at other long term care

facilities are schedule in accordance with the dates on which the first dose was administered. These vaccinations have been administered via a State and Federal partnership with Walgreens and CVS.

**Cases related to Long-Term Care and Assisted Living Facilities**

Interim Public Health Director Terry reports no changes in Long Term Care facilities since February 10, 2021.

**Public Health Data**

Interim Public Health Director Terry has shared the following data related to COVID-19.

“New cases per 100,000 People”. This metric looks at the number of recent COVID-19 cases per 100,000 people to describe the potential number of people who are currently ill and may be infectious. This is the number of new cases reported by IDPH in the previous week. Calculated as a rate = [Village of Oak Park case count for 7 days] / [Village population] x100,000.

- Oak Park rate: 73/100,000
- Cook County rate: 181/100,000 1/17/2021 through 1/23/2021)
- Target for County-level data: Cases for the week are fewer than 10 or the rate is fewer than 50 cases per 100,000 people
- Warning for County-level data: New case rate is greater than 50 cases per 100,000 people

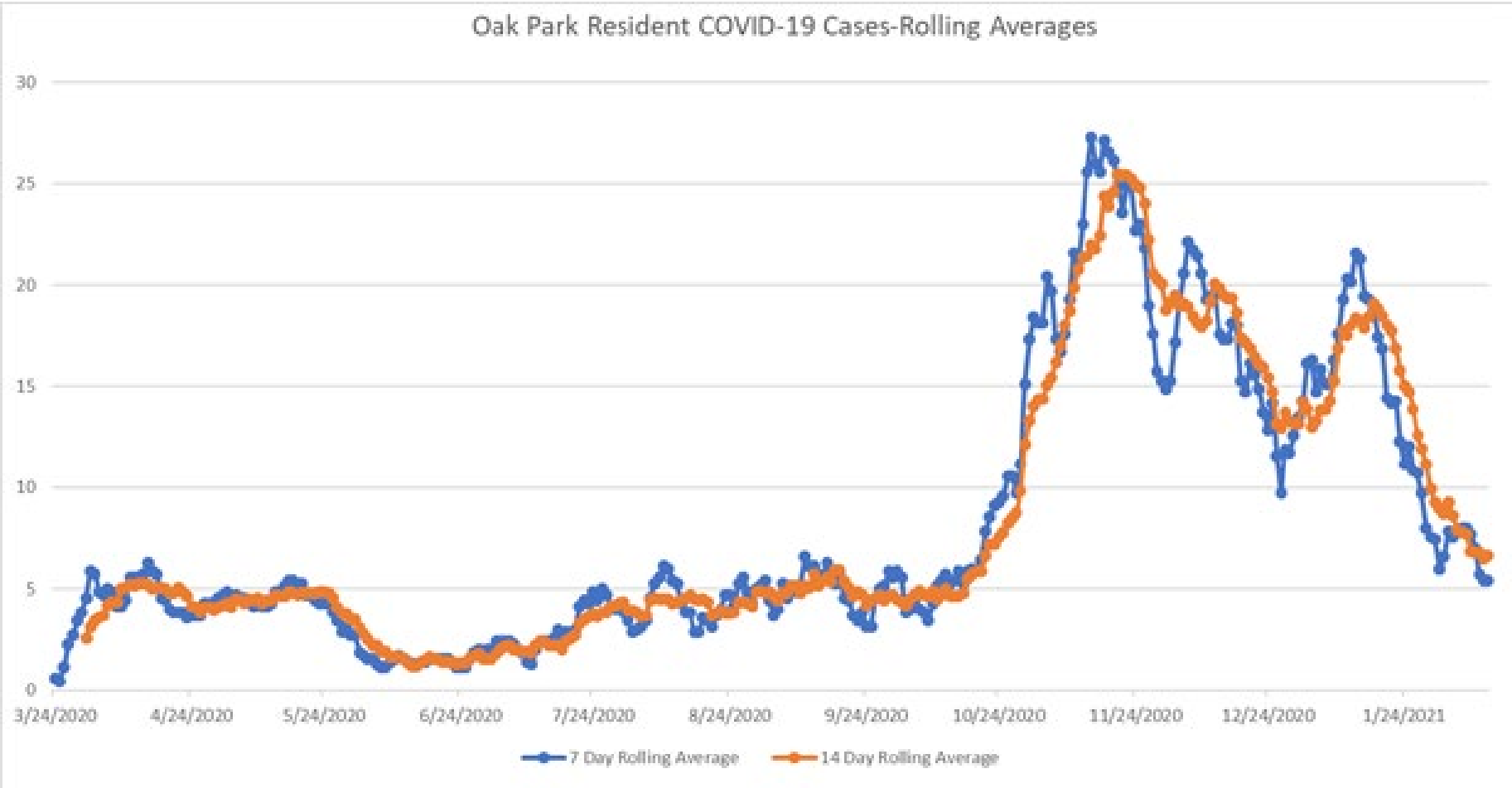

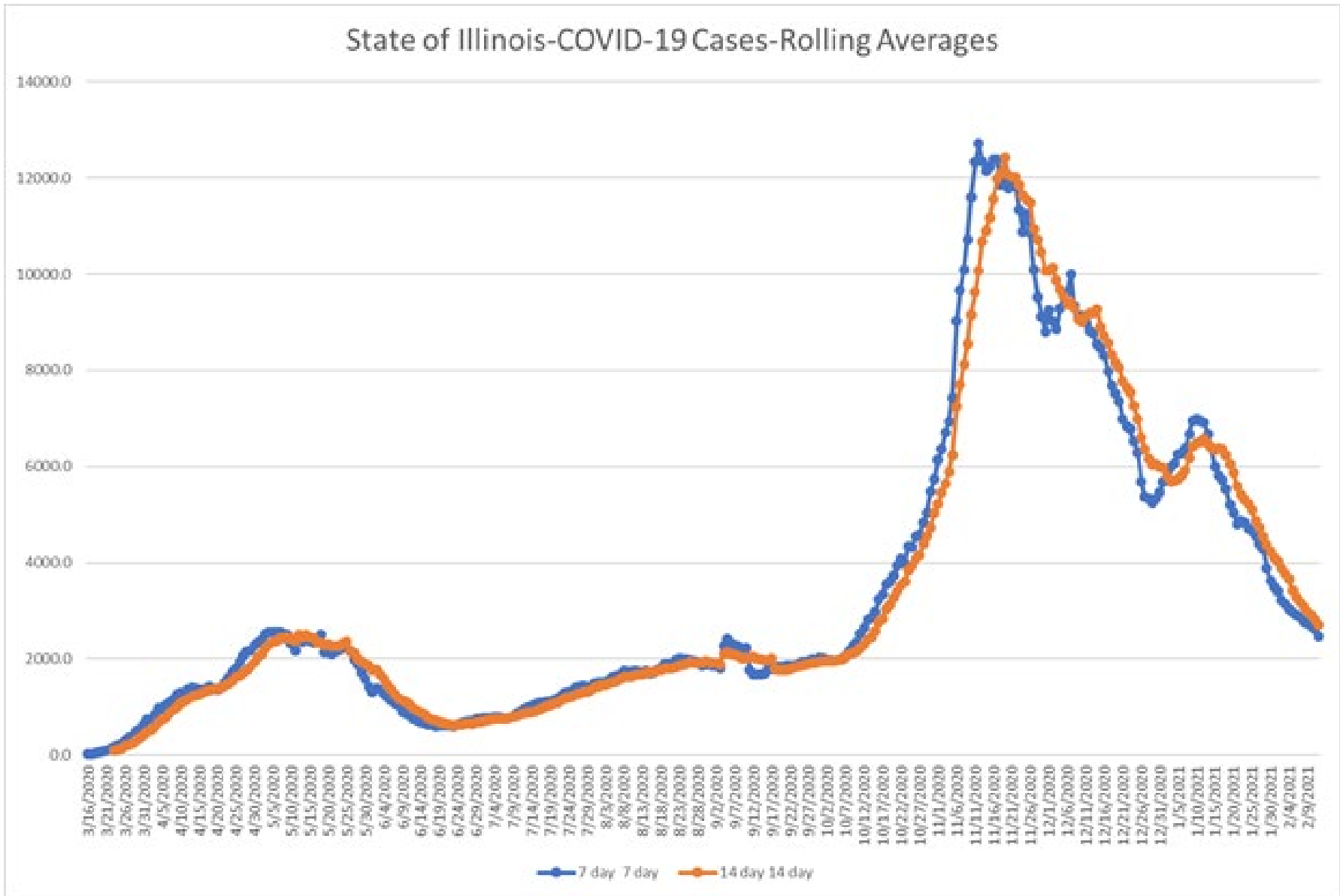
