

**Minutes of the Liquor Control Review Board**

1. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 7:38 p.m.

  - A. **Application of Hospitality Services Group LLC for a Class D-8 Park District of Oak Park Subsidiary Liquor License**  
  
Todd Armbruster introduced himself as the representative of Hospitality Services Group LLC (“Applicant”). The Applicant seeks a Class D-8 license for Park District of Oak Park and Oak Park Library events, such as weddings, which include the Applicant’s bartenders. Mr. Armbruster previously maintained a liquor license with the Village under the name Services Us. The Applicant maintains a BASSET certification and all its bartenders are Bassett certified. Previously, the Applicant was issued same-day event liquor licenses, which cost \$50 for each event. A Class D-8 liquor license will save the Applicant money over time based upon the number of events it has booked.

A motion was made by Member Keeku and seconded by Member Conniff to recommend approval of a Class D-8 liquor license for Hospital Services Group LLC.

B. Application of I'm Hot Sauce Company, DBA Taste of Brasil for a Restaurant Class B-4 Liquor License at 211 Harrison Street
