Item Title: UPDATE AND ON-GOING DISCUSSION OF PARKING STUDY

Review Date: October 23, 2017

Prepared By: Parking and Mobility Services

Abstract (briefly describe the item being reviewed):

At the August 28, 2017 and also September 25, 2017 Transportation Commission Meetings an update on the parking study was submitted by staff. The commission discussed with the consultant a series of recommendations and next steps for the parking study. The next steps and recommendations will be discussed further and pending commission approval at this meeting, a series of pilot recommendations will be brought forth at the next transportation commission meeting. In addition stake holder feedback will be sought for that larger pilot study discussion.

Discussion points and theories, including consultant recommendations for the following items:

- Street sweeping
- No parking Time Restrictions
- Paid Parking Options
- Zone Areas
- Permit Parking Options
- Overnight/Extended Passes VS Guest Permits
- Commuter Parking
- Parking lots
- Vehicle Sticker
- Enforcement
- Stakeholder Feedback
- Max days a car can park

Additionally, staff has looked at dates to hold the forum and needs to act quickly to properly market and attract stakeholders to the forum.

- Pleasant Home is open on 8 @ 7pm – holds max of 100
- Mills Park Tower is open on 8 @ 7pm in community room – holds a max of 80 people (However, we do not recommend utilizing the 8th since D97 will hold a large community concert at the High School.)
- Brooks is open only on the 9 @ 6pm and 8pm – Commons room holds a max of 300 people

To Whom It May Concern:

I'm sending this email because I would like to discuss the parking situation.

I live at 102-104 W Washington which is between Taylor & Lombard on the North side of the street. I would like to complain about the fact that I nor the other tenants cannot overnight park in front of our building where we pay an astronomical amount in rent. Because of some 40 or 50 year old Village Ordinance which states that **“single family residential frontage for any block with the “multiple family” zone district exceeds fifth percent (50%) of the total lineal feet of the frontage for such block..... (which still does not make since to me)**

I have taken the liberty of attaching videos to show that the four 2 unit buildings have 4 to 5 car garages or space attached in the back. For that reason along, they don't need front overnight parking. Also, please notice that there are no actual signs stating that there's no overnight parking as well.

It's also extremely difficult trying to find a place to park on Tuesday and Wednesday. Because they have street cleaning on those days, finding a place to park is very frustrating especially when there's open space directly in front of my building. I nor other tenants in the building and the other commercial building should not have to park on Austin or other locations and walk all the way back to their apartment.

With all the new construction that's going on and around Oak Park, I seriously do not understand why there's still soooooo many parking issues. I really think it's now time for a change and allow for the North side of Washington between Taylor & Lombard to allow for overnight parking.

I will be attending the meeting on Monday to discuss this further.

Proposal for Pilot Parking Study

Study area

The proposed pilot area for this study comprises the district of the Village that is bordered by Harlem Avenue, Oak Park Boulevard, Madison Street, and South Boulevard. For purposes of this project we refer to this area as the HOMS district.

Characteristics of study area

The HOMS district presents many parking challenges due to a variety of characteristics:

- Single-family dwellings
- Multi-family dwellings
- Commuter rail line
- Business district

Timeframe

This pilot project is proposed to begin in January 2018 and continue for nine months, concluding in September 2018. At the conclusion of the pilot project, and based on data gathered during the pilot, recommendations will be made to the Village Board regarding next steps.

Problems to be addressed

- Business employees and commuters parked in front of residences
- Unknown vehicles parked in front of residences for extended periods
- Lack of overnight parking spaces
- Multiple regulations, causes confusion for residents and visitors
- Multiple regulations, creates enforcement challenges
- Confusing signage
- Residents and employees unable to afford permits
- Limited customer parking close to businesses

Pilot parking regulation recommendations

The following recommendations are made in an attempt to address the challenges presented above.

- No parking on residential streets between 8AM-10AM, Monday-Saturday. This regulation will prevent commuters from parking in front of residences.
- Two-hour parking limit on residential streets between 10AM-6PM, Monday-Saturday. This regulation will prevent business employees from parking in front of residences.

- Rather than multiple permit zones, the entire HOMS district will comprise one zone and all permit holders will be permitted to park anywhere within this zone. This will open up additional spaces for overnight parkers.
- Only permit holders, including residents and visitors of residents, will be permitted to park in front of residences between 9PM-10AM, Sunday-Saturday. This regulation will enforce the Village-wide overnight parking ban.
- Permit holders are permitted to park in metered spaces without payment, between 6PM-8AM, Sunday-Saturday. This regulation will open up additional spaces for permit holders.
- Permit holders with 24/7 permits will be required to park in garages or parking lots. This regulation will open up additional spaces for overnight resident and visitor permit holders.
- Commuter and employee permit holders will be required to park in garages and parking lots, rather than on-street at meters. This will open up spaces close to businesses.
- Subsidized permits will be available to lower-income residents and employees. This will help address the concerns raised about the high cost of permits.
- One of two options will be selected to address the concerns about permit holders remaining parked on street for extended periods of time:
 - Option 1: Enforce an ODD/EVEN parking regulation. This regulation would require all permit holders to park on the ODD side of the street on odd dates, and park on the EVEN side of the street on even dates.
 - Option 2: Enforce a 72-hour parking regulation. This regulation would require all permit holders to move their vehicles within 72 hours, to the alternate side of the street or a different block.
- Restrict on-street meter parking, between 8AM-6PM, Monday-Saturday, to a 3-hour time limit. This will prevent employees from parking in spaces that should be available to customers.

Additional Recommendations

- Enforcement efforts concentrated in the HOMS district, with one Community Service Officer (CSO) enforcing this area between 8AM and 6PM, and another CSO enforcing this area between 6PM and 8AM, with exact schedules to be determined.
- CSOs in this area will utilize mobile License Plate Recognition equipment in their vehicles to expediate and facilitate enforcement.
- Streamlined signage will be developed and deployed throughout the pilot area.

Evaluation

Throughout the pilot project, feedback will be obtained from all relevant stakeholders, including:

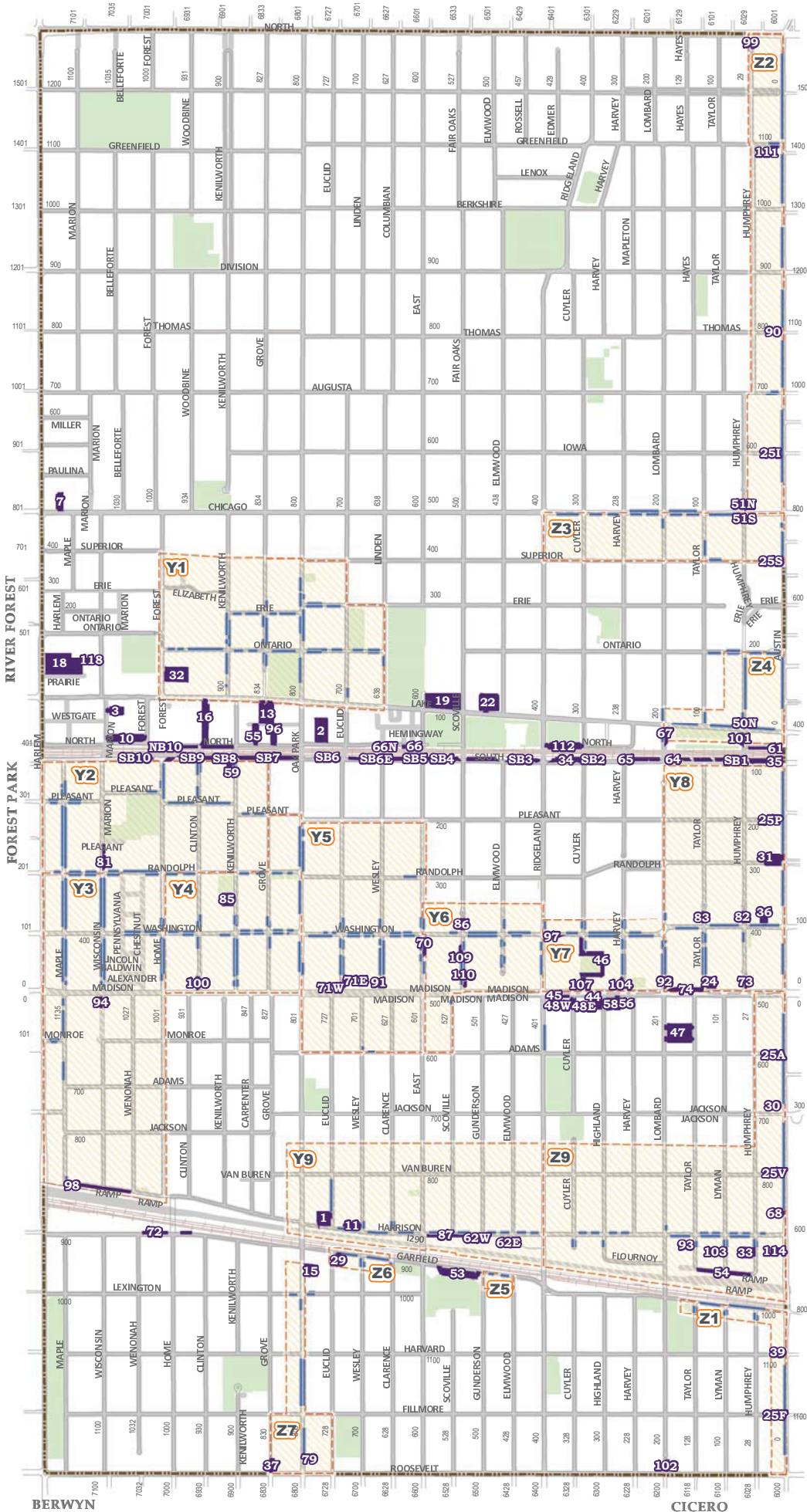
- Residents

- Business Owners
- Employees
- Village parking staff
- Transportation Commission

In addition to stakeholder feedback, occupancy counts will be performed and compared to data gathered in prior studies within the HOMS district. A recommendations report will be developed based on the evaluation and shared with Village staff, Transportation Commission and Village Board. At this point, decisions will be made regarding the future of parking in the Village of Oak Park.

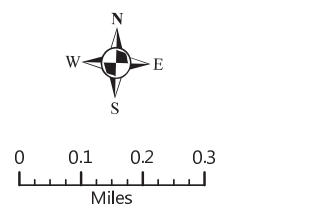
