The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m.

There were no public comments.

There was a motion to approve the May 15, 2018 minutes. The motion to approve minutes was proposed by Committee Member Nowicki, seconded by Committee Member Becker. Ayes: All, Nays: None. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Acting Police Chief Reynolds gave an update on training and staffing. Command staff will be sent to the FBI Executive Leadership Group. Six candidates will be coming in September and October. Two School Resource Officers have been appointed to Oak Park River Forest High School and Brooks Middle School. Two officers were assigned to the Detective Bureau; Detective Sperandio will retire on September 23, 2018 after 27 years to become the SRO of Fenwick High School. More training in Risk Management will be in August. Deputy Chief Limon and five commanders will attend the Midwest Security Expo. Officers are doing a good job.

There was a motion by Committee Member Nowicki seconded by Committee Member Luttig to go into Executive Session. Ayes: All, Nays: None. The meeting adjourned to Executive Session at 7:57 p.m.

There was discussion on the on-going discussions to revamp procedures, year-end report, review of officer conduct and what does the Village expect of the group. These items will be discussed with HR Director, Assistant Village Manager Julia Scott-Valdez.
