- Mac Robinet opened a discussion in favor of moving toward 100% electrification and the elimination of fossil fuel usage.
- The Commission discussed the feasibility of alternative energy and the impact on both existing and new buildings.
- The Commission asked exactly what direction does the board have about electrification. Was the directive to have 100% electrification of the Village or shall it only apply to new construction? They are still looking for clarification from the board for definitive direction.
- The Commission discussed inviting Mr. Robinet back to provide a presentation at a future meeting, since materials had not been made available to the Commission or public in advance.
- Commissioner Easty mentioned engineering economics evaluation concerning the options we are
 exploring to try to help reduce our impact on our climate will include everything from the cost to
 source the raw materials out of the ground through the lifecycle cost of implementing such a
 system. This needs to include not only the type of fuel used to power such equipment but also the
 maintenance costs as well as longevity of such equipment along with the replacement
 costs. Anything less is a disservice to the effort. Such a full analysis is pretty complex and will
 take significant effort and time.
